#### **Position of *visiting researcher***

#### **at the Institute of Philosophy of Ignatianum University in Cracow**

1. The Institute of Philosophy offers interested academic staff employed at Polish or foreign universities the opportunity to undertake a research internship in the field of philosophy and ethics.
2. An intern who meets the following conditions may be granted the status of *visiting researcher*, and their stay may be certified by the Director of the Institute of Philosophy.
3. The Institute provides:
  - a) support from a research mentor.
  - b) access to the University Library and its services.
4. Conditions for obtaining the position of *visiting researcher*:
  - a) a person wishing to undertake a research internship shall, prior to arrival, agree with the Director of the Institute who will act as their mentor (this should be a full-time employee of the University in the field of philosophy).
  - b) the person agrees with the mentor on the research programme for their stay, which is approved by the Director of the Institute.
  - c) on-site activity at the University should last a minimum of 14 days.
  - d) the person should give at least one presentation at the Research Seminar of the Institute of Philosophy (lecture + discussion).
  - e) as part of the internship (but not necessarily during physical presence), the person should prepare a scientific article in cooperation with a selected academic employee from the discipline of philosophy at UIK and submit it together to a leading journal in the discipline/field (100 points and above).
  - f) it is recommended that the researcher review a selected philosophical book for 'Forum Philosophicum' (preferably a book by an employee of the Institute of Philosophy, but not necessarily).
  - g) *visiting researchers* may conduct classes for students or doctoral students in the form of research seminars lasting no more than 10 teaching hours. The mentor is responsible for organising the classes.
  - h) Other academic activities aimed at developing international cooperation are welcome.
5. The research internship at the Institute is unpaid.
6. Accommodation and meals in Krakow are to be arranged by the intern.
7. The mentor may receive a certificate confirming supervision of the visiting researcher internship issued by the Director of the Institute of Philosophy.
